President's Report:

- The application for tuition reimbursement for members and scholarship for their children entering college is on the website. The deadline to submit their application is September 19th, 2022.
- Juneteenth which was given to union members by the governor is not a legal holiday. The legislators have yet to approve Juneteenth as a legal holiday. Any members who work that day, will get pay as overtime not as regular Holiday, until approved by the State Legislators.
- •The incoming Mayor, Mr. Eric Adams, will not negotiate a new contract with DC-37 until he has a decent plan for the Health Care crisis for New York City residents. The mayor will not be able to give the union a decent contract because the Health Care program will consume most of the money from the budget. Once we have a new contract, the money will be retroactive for both active and retiree members.

Officer's Report:

- Public Relation Officer Brian Cohen: Back in June, some of the members expressed that they had problem joining the email distribution list, on the website. There are two (2) places on the website where members can sign up for email and one of them was broken. Now, there is only one place for members to access the distribution list.
